On 6 and 7 November 2014, the third MeVeL partnership meeting and a MeVeL workshop for trainers took place in Graz, Austria. On the first day of the meeting, the MeVeL project partners and their trainers from Italy, Spain, Austria, and Turkey introduced the seminar modules they had developed. On the Moodle learning platform, final adaptations and adjustments were made with regard to course content, duration and structure.

The second meeting day concentrated on the Moodle training for the MeVeL trainers to prepare them for their virtual teaching programme within the MeVeL course. Eight trainers from the partner countries got acquainted with the Moodle learning platform in the training facilities of bfi Steiermark.

They will invite all interested production managers, team leaders and heads of production in the metal industry to register for the **SMART TOOLS FOR PRODUCTION MANAGERS** course for free.
